It is an electric bike converted from an abandoned bike. It works on 1000 W BLDC auto gear motor and 48 V lithium-ion battery. It is loaded with first in class features like smart battery management system, Real time GPS connectivity, Parental control and anti-theft. Any two-wheeler can be converted into an electric bike or scooter; hence people don't need to buy a new electric bike or scooter, they can convert their old two wheelers and use it as an electric vehicle, hence it is pocket friendly. Subsequently the bike was demonstrated at Odisha Startup Conclave 2022 at Utkal Chamber of Commerce and Industry Ltd. Bhubaneswar. Also Dr. Imran Khan, CEO e bikes go India took a test ride of the bike and was very much impressed with the features offered in it.
