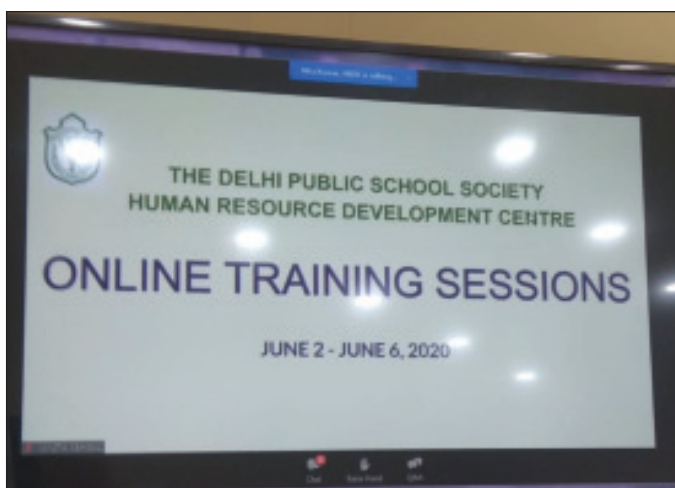


Dry food distribution to COVID Warriors & needy people by Delhi Public School, Dhenkanal
