

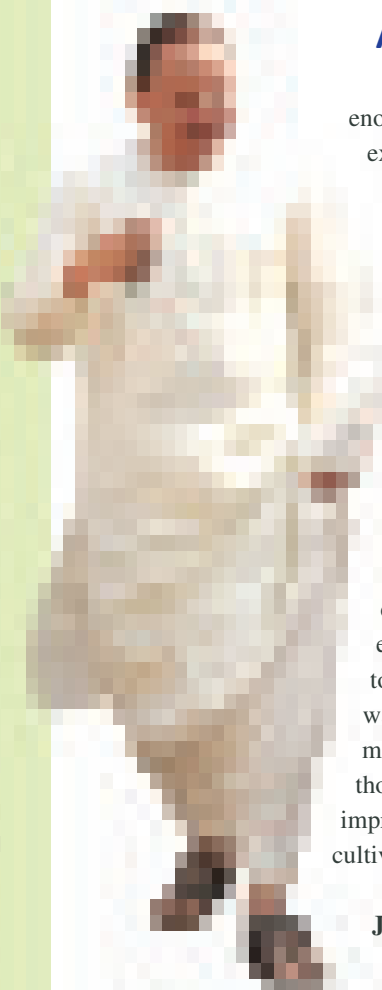

A good Communication skill is the path to success

To succeed in a corporate world it is not enough to generate good ideas. It is not enough to do real, solid hard work, you have to stand up and present your ideas to external and internal audiences. 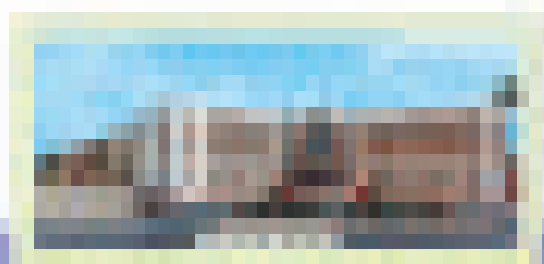

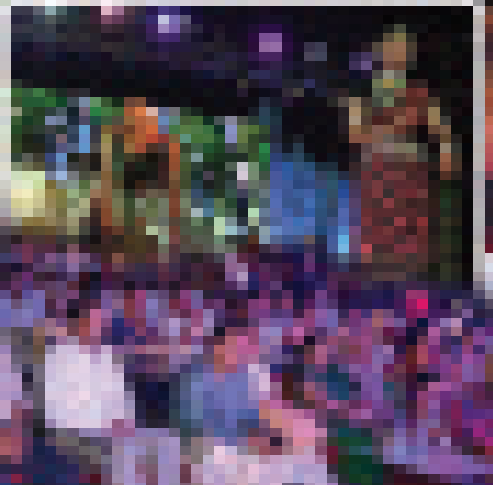
Lecture Seminar Series
