
Message from The Chairman.....

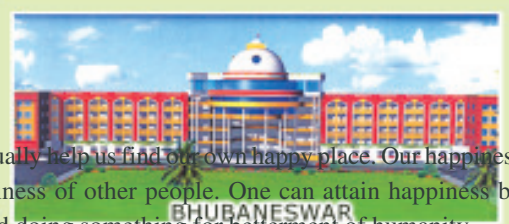

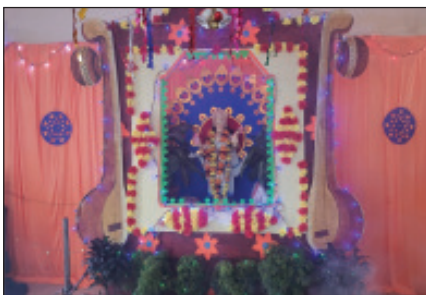
love and happiness to felicitate the woman employees of the institution
