Message From The Chairman.....

Time Bank

During my last visit to Switzerland, I came to know about a substantial facility of the country's government for the senior citizens. When I was staying at the hotel, I met an old woman who was the landlady of a house situated in front of my hotel. She was a retired teacher from a secondary school. One day, while I was having a conversation with her about the schemes of our respective countries, I happened to know that the pension scheme in Switzerland is convenient and enough to not worry about food and shelter in later years. However, she still found 'work' of taking care of an 87 year old single man. I asked her if she was working for money. But her answer surprised me. She said that, "I do not work for money, but I put my time in the 'Time Bank', and when I cannot move in my old age, I can withdraw it". It was the first time that I had heard of something like this. Being Curious, I asked her more about this concept of "Time Bank". The original "Time Bank" was an old-age pension program developed by the Swiss Federal Ministry of Social Security.

People saved their 'time' taking care of the elderly people when they were younger, and when they grew old, ill or needed care, could withdraw it. The applicants must be healthy, good at communicating and affectionate. Every day they have to look after the elderly who needed help. Their service hours would be deposited into the personal 'Time Accounts' of the social security system. She went to work twice a week, spending two hours each time helping the elderly for shopping, cleaning their room, taking them out to sunbathe, chatting with them etc. According to the agreement, after one year of her service, "Time Bank" will calculate her working hours and issue her a "Time Bank Card". Whenever she needed someone to take care of her, she could use her "Time Bank Card" to "withdraw time and time interest". After the information verification, "Time Bank" will assign other volunteers to take care of her at the hospital or her home. Today, in Switzerland, the use of "time banks" to support old age has become a common practice. This not only saves the country's pension expenses, but also solves other social problems. Many Swiss citizens are very supportive of this kind of old-age pension. At present the number of "empty-nest old people" in Asian countries is increasing and it has gradually become a social problem. The adoption of such a scheme in India could reduce the insecurities of the senior citizens and empower them for a secured future. Though, I hope that such a scheme gets introduced in our country in the near future, I also pray to all that we should not forget our responsibilities towards our parents. We should take care of them and their needs when they grow old. It is my sincere request to everyone to help the old people and take care of their needs.

Online Interaction Programme with 2019-20 Passout Class X students at Delhi Public School, Dhenkanal

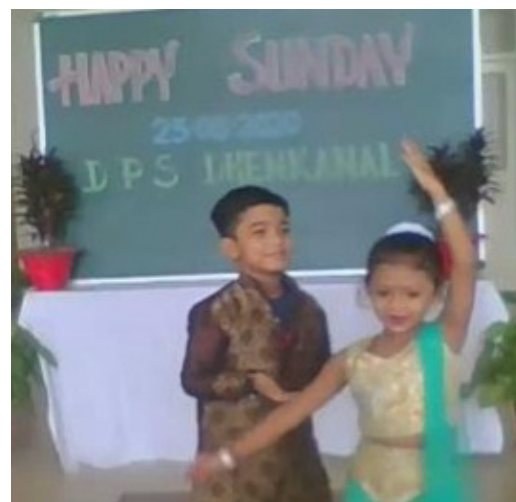

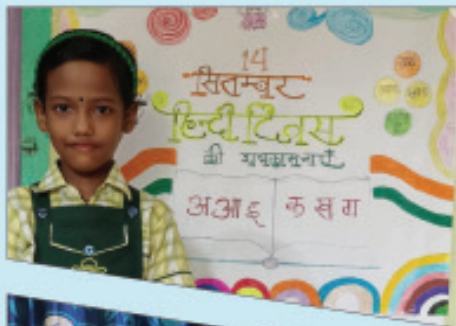
Online Teachers Day Celebration at Delhi Public School, Dhenkanal
