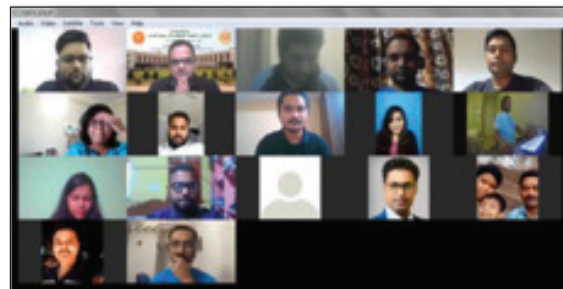

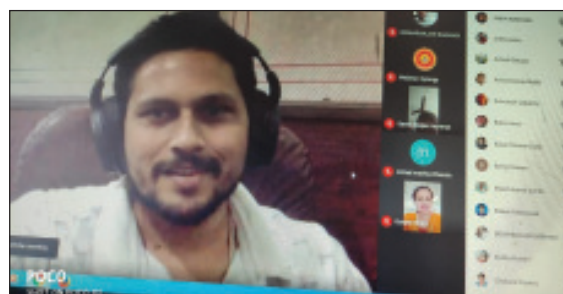
Virtual Alumni Meet by Synergy, Dhenkanal
